ORDINANCE

On Amending Bank of Russia Ordinance No. 1778-U, dated 26 December 2006, ‘On Validity Criteria and Rules for Exchange of Bank of Russia Banknotes and Coins’*

1. Amend Bank of Russia Ordinance No. 1778-U, dated 26 December 2006, ‘On Validity Criteria and Rules for Exchange of Bank of Russia Banknotes and Coins’, registered with the Ministry of Justice of the Russian Federation on 16 January 2007 under No. 8748 (Bank of Russia Bulletin No. 5 dated 31 January 2007) as follows.

1.1. In sub-clause 2.4 of clause 2, replace the word ‘transportation’ with ‘transportation and storage’.

1.2. In clause 4, add the following paragraph:

‘The procedure for exchanging Bank of Russia banknotes stained with special ink which is resistant to solvents and chemicals and has other distinctive characteristics enabling its detection on a Bank of Russia banknote and designed to prevent the theft of Bank of Russia banknotes during their transportation and storage shall be established by Bank of Russia regulation’.

2. This Ordinance shall become effective 10 days after the official publication in the Bank of Russia Bulletin.
